The CCAA Museum of Art announces the second annual exhibit of the works of internationally-renowned artist Milford Zornes. The exhibit is entitled **The Art of Milford Zornes: Friendships and Inspiration** and will be on display at the CCAA Museum of Art from December 12, 2010 to February 20, 2011.

The exhibit features the work of 17 artists who have had a significant connection to Milford, combined with 47 Zornes works from private collections, some of which have never before been exhibited.

Three receptions are planned during the exhibit run. The opening reception will be held on December 12, 2010; a Milford Zornes birthday celebration on January 23, 2011; and the closing reception on February 20, 2011. All receptions will be from 2 pm to 4 pm at the CCAA Museum of Art, located in the historic J. Filippi Winery in Rancho Cucamonga.

Following the death of Milford Zornes in 2009, the CCAA Museum of Art was selected by the Zornes family to host an annual exhibit of the artist's work. The inaugural exhibit, entitled **The Art of Milford Zornes: from Private Collections**, featured works loaned by private collectors, as well as a never-exhibited work from the Zornes family private collection.

The Chaffey Community Art Association (CCAA) was founded in the spring of 1941 by Francis and Helen Line of Ontario, California in memory of their daughter Barbara who died of leukemia at the age of eight. CCAA is among the oldest organizations in the Inland Empire dedicated to stimulating and fostering an interest in the California School of Artists as well as other local artists from the Chaffey Community. Its many activities include

- maintaining a the CCAA Museum of Art and gallery in the historic Joseph Filippi Winery in Rancho Cucamonga;
- mounting changing exhibits of local artists;
- hosting artist receptions, often in conjunction with wine tastings from the Filippi cellars;
- sponsoring conversations and discussions with artists;
- holding fundraisers such as art auctions and an annual Honor the Artist event; and
- providing open studio modeling sessions for artists.

The CCAA Museum of Art is located in the North Wing of the Joseph Filippi Winery, 12467 Baseline Road, Rancho Cucamonga, CA 91739. The museum hours are Friday through Sunday from noon to 5 p.m.
